Welcome to the beginning of the season everyone!

- BeJ wants to give a hearty welcome to all the new fellas this year! Jerry Broida, Bob Franklin, Larry Harwin, Al Yendick, Marv Litt, Nick Altwerger, Norm Schwartz, Scott Sternthal, and Larry Sandler! Happy to have you all aboard the BeJ train! We also welcome back our injured bretheren from last year. Oft-injured Mark Klinger, Larry Slutsky, Jerry Rose and Mike Rosen. Looking forward to a Happy and Healthy season!
- For you new guys, we bowl a 24 point system. 7 points per game, and three for team totals. Each game, there are 4 head-to-head match points, and 3 points for totals. We use 90% handicap, team from 850.
- As a reminder, alleys 15-16 each week will begin about 25 minutes or so after the rest of the league. Not a damn thing we can do about it, so plan accordingly! Each team will only be affected 3-4 times the entire season.. The next weeks schedule will be listed on the sheet each week. Those sheets, and other weekly and league notes will also be on our website every week. All that information will be on the *"This weeks info"* section.
- Please remember, you "new" guys with no average, you will bowl NINE games to establish your average. You will bowl for score only, not individual points. You can still enter certain jackpots. Your score for team points will be a 170 frozen.
- Please give your team a NAME tonight. Last warning, then I'll do it myself! I promise it may be more entertaining than you'll probably want. For those of you whom I didn't get a team photo of last week, I will try to get you tonight! And quit 'yer crying too.
- TONIGHT, we will start the Progressive Mystery Pot. This is just like the Regular Mystery Game, except only ONE number will be called each night. Since this is a "carry-over" pot, you must be entered before the pot begins. Once we start, you will be unable to enter until a winner has been picked. ALSO, you must be paid for every week the pot goes on. (SO, even if you miss a week, it must be paid) Feel free to pay up \$28 for the entire first half or \$62 for the season! Paying \$2 per week works, but it's a pain in my ass. 😊 The number will be drawn after the 2nd game each week.
- Out and about tonight, is a list, and details about all the jackpots we have floating around! *Make sure you hit the ATM before bowling!*

OFFICIAL Jackpot Definitions / Rules & Regulations

Closest to 200:

ALL three games, a number will be drawn between 195-205. The score closest to the number chosen will win the pot. Total monies collected divided by three.
\$5 entry fee

FOR Viewing ONLY. Do Not take.

Mystery Game:

First two games only. Total monies collected divided by two. Numbers will be drawn after everyone has completed games one, and two.
\$5 entry fee

High Middle Game w/Handicap:

Middle game only, the highest score wins.
\$5 entry fee



High Over Average:

Jackpot is for Single Game, and Series. Total monies collected divided by two. High Single Game over Average, and High three game series over average WINS.
\$5 entry fee

Progressive Mystery:

Similar to the regular mystery game, but ONLY one number drawn each week. If no winner picked, pot carries over to the next week. \$2 per week, per man. Must be entered before the first drawing, or you will be ineligible to enter until the first winner has been picked. Number picked will be for game TWO bowled, and will be drawn after all teams have completed their 2nd game. If you do NOT pay a week, you will be eliminated, as this is a CARRYOVER pot.

High 3rd game Scratch:

3rd game only, HIGH Game. NO handicap.
\$5 entry fee

Precision Ball:

See separate sheet. Run by Ron Malach, and his pals.

ALL the above Jackpots will be paid the following week.

Other Jackpots

Card game

Poker style game, run by Mitch Lefton. Every mark made, you get a card. Best high, or low hand wins. Entry, \$10 per man.



Crazy 8 pot

"Bracket" tournament, run by Ben Shapiro. Exactly like the NCAA tournament bracket, matched up against another bowler.. \$10 per man to enter, normally top THREE winners get paid.

Texas Hold 'em Card Game

Run by Tom at the Counter.. , \$10 per man.

"Precision Ball" Jackpot

The Precision Ball Jackpot will be run as follows:

1. **Only ONE ticket will be drawn. Whoever possesses the winning ticket will get a chance to bowl for the jackpot. The LAST number on the winning ticket will be the number of pins the bowler has to knock down to win the jackpot. Example: If the ticket is #64583, the bowler would have to throw a THREE count to win the the pot. If the bowler does NOT win the entire jackpot, he will earn the amount of pins knocked down, in dollars. The balance of the pot would carry over to the next week.**
2. **The first six weeks, the jackpot will be open to all. Then, starting in week seven, a bowler must have bowled at least 40% of the weeks to date to be eligible to purchase tickets.**
3. **Any bowler entering a jackpot, and especially winning the jackpot is expected to be in good standing with the league, or they must bring themselves up to good standing at that time. Payouts will NOT be made until their responsibilities are satisfied.**
4. **The person holding the chosen ticket is the only person able to bowl.**
5. **Cost guidelines: TEN tickets for \$5**
6. **If the jackpot exceeds \$500, after the initial bowler bowls, ONE additional ticket will be drawn for the chance at \$50. If the pot is not hit, NO additional \$ value will be awarded.**
7. **Due to House regulations, if the jackpot reaches \$999, a second jackpot will be created for that week. The first jackpot will stand at \$900, with the balance being in jackpot number two. A ticket for each jackpot will be drawn, and the above rules will apply to BOTH jackpots.**
8. **Tickets will be sold until teams have finished their 2nd game, and only then will tickets be drawn for jackpots**
9. **The lane chosen for bowling will be determined at the same time of the drawing. Bowlers will NOT be able to jackpot bowl on the same pair of alleys they have been, or are bowling on that night.**
10. **Lost tickets are not our responsibility, and will not be dealt with at any time. Losing your tickets most likely will cause you immense ridicule. Don't lose your tickets.**
11. **Final night of bowling: If the jackpot remains, tickets will continue to be drawn until all the jackpots have been broken.**
